**ORDER SETTING DEADLINES AND
EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

1. Hearing Setting. The Court will hold an evidentiary hearing on the confirmation of the Debtor’s amended chapter 11 plan at 9:30 a.m. on February 18, 2021, in the United States Bankruptcy Court, 700 Stewart Street, Courtroom 8106, Seattle, Washington.

2. Compliance. Failure to comply with the procedures and deadlines set forth in this order may result in sanctions pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16(f)(1) without further notice. Sanctions for failure to comply with this order may be ordered without further notice and may include striking pleadings and rendering an adverse judgment against the disobedient party.

1 3. Deadlines. Unless altered by a subsequent order, the parties shall comply with the
2 following deadlines.

3 a. Disclosure of Witnesses. The parties shall provide a list of all potential witnesses
4 to opposing counsel by December 30, 2020.

5 b. Exhibits. The parties shall exchange their proposed exhibits by February 4,
6 2021.

7 c. Briefs. The parties shall file a hearing brief no longer than ten pages by February
8 11, 2021.

9 4. Exhibits.

10 a. Numbering and Format. A number sequence shall be used for all exhibits
11 (including experts' declarations) of all parties, with prefixes indicating the
12 offering party, debtor or creditor (i.e., D1, D2, D3, etc; C1, C2, C3, etc.).
13 Exhibits shall be pre-marked in accordance with this order. Any documentary
14 exhibits which can reasonably be submitted on 8-1/2 by 11 inch paper shall be,
15 with text on one side only.

16 b. Binders. Any party submitting exhibits shall submit the exhibits in 3-ring
17 binders. The binders shall include an index of the exhibits and each exhibit shall
18 be separated with an index tab marked with the identification as set forth in
19 paragraph 4(a).

20 c. Submission of Exhibits to Court. Parties intending to offer exhibits shall submit
21 four sets of exhibits in 3-ring binders for use by the Court, the clerk, and
22 witnesses to chambers no later than February 12, 2021.

23 5. Settlement. The parties shall promptly notify the Court if the matter is settled.

24 6. Confirmation. The moving party shall confirm that the hearing is going forward not later
25 than noon on February 12, 2021 and so advise all parties. Failure to comply may result
in the hearing being stricken. Please confirm the hearing using the E-Docket
