



NEIGHBORHOOD IMPACTS

- Increased risk of youth and pedestrian accidents
- Headlight glare in homes, increased vehicular noise
- Arterial traffic unnecessarily rerouted, loss of neighborhood privacy
- Loss of natural buffer between neighborhood and gun range

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

- Destruction of a WDFW Priority Habitat Species area, including forest and scrub areas
- Destruction of three Swamp Creek tributaries and a critical wetland
- Increased flooding and sediment deposits in Swamp Creek downstream
- Mitigation at Bear Creek would not help Swamp Creek
